

Memorial Grants Programme

(Approved February 2003 and correct as at January 2010)

*All within Queensland on a dollar-for-dollar basis with upper limits shown.
There is an overall limit of \$10 000 per organisation per year.*

War Memorials

War Memorials(new) Associated with the holding of marches and/or services on ANZAC Day:

- a. When total incurred expenditure does not exceed \$50 000. **\$5000**
- b. When incurred expenditure exceeds \$50 000 then 10% of expenditure to a maximum of. **\$10 000**

War Memorials (restorations) for existing memorials, including the cost of moving to more suitable locations. **\$2500**

School Memorials associated with holding ANZAC Day services—bronze plaques. **Free of Charge**

Memorial Halls (major repairs) provided the halls are associated with holding ANZAC Day observances, including painting in the event of a natural disaster, but not including routine painting and maintenance. **\$2500**

Military Museums containing memorabilia from wars in which Australians have served, provided such museums are, from time to time, open to the public. Subsidies for new facilities or projects within an existing museum. **\$5000**

Memorabilia Cabinets (new and restored) containing items from wars in which Australians have served, provided the cabinets are in museum type buildings which are, from time to time, open to the public. . . . **\$1000**

Honour Boards (new) **\$2000**

Honour Boards (restored/additions) **\$1000**

Graves Memorials

Grave/Niche Sites of veterans who die from other than war-related causes. **\$250**

Memorial Cemeteries for veterans who die from other than war-related causes including restoration of veterans' grave sites (per year limit). **\$1000**

Headstones for veterans who die from other than war-related causes (new or previously unmarked) and repairs (\$1000 maximum/cemetery/year). **\$250**

Grave/Niche Plaques (bronze) for veterans who die from other than war-related causes. **50% of cost**

Memorial Badges (bronze) for grave and niche marking of Australian veterans who die from other than war-related causes. **Free of Charge**
